Maths Challenge

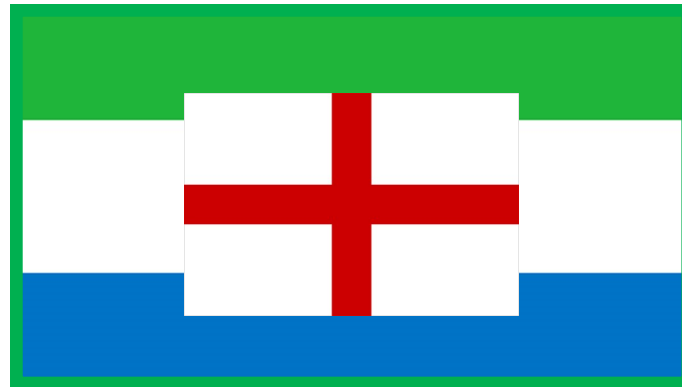
In your book, draw pictures to represent the following division expressions:
