As Historians we will...

turn our focus to our local area, discovering how Isaac Reckitt developed a family run business from humble beginnings to the global leader in household products and pharmaceuticals that it is today. As well as the involvement of Thomas Ferens, who became managing director of the company, we will also learn how Isaac's background as a Quaker fed into his nurturing attitude towards staff, even down to building quality homes for the workers. We will discuss how both the Reckitts family and Thomas Ferens sought to build a better, fairer and more equal society for all. We will make links with prior learning by comparing the impact the Reckitts Family and Ferens had on society with other local heroes, such as Mary Murdoch and Amy Johnson, and how individuals, companies and groups have sought to use their beliefs to inspire others.

As Scientists we will...

gain an understanding of scientific processes involving materials, such as separating solutions and mixtures, changing states and reversible and irreversible changes. Through observations, investigations and measurements, we will begin to identify, classify and group a variety of materials and processes, record and present our findings in different ways and use our new knowledge to interpret, evaluate and pose new questions to extend our learning further.

In PE we will...

engage in a variety of invasion games, analysing our use of tactics and continuing to build our fitness. We will also participate in sessions with a specialist Judo coach, developing our strength, coordination and teamwork.

In the Arts we will...
