Go and visit the River Hull or the Humber Estuary with your family. Draw a picture of the features you can see.

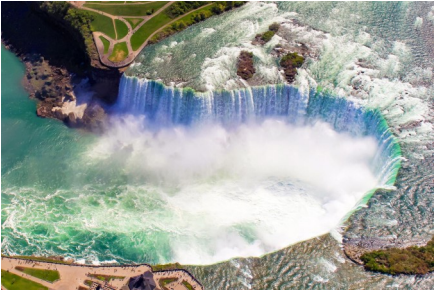
Reflect on it!
