On Monday 30th June the school nurses are coming into the Year 6 classes to talk about 'Relationships and Sex Education'. These talks are delivered in an age appropriate way in line with our RSE curriculum unit 'Changing Me'.

The sessions are regularly updated based on JIGSAW information and on recommendations from PSHE Association <https://pshe-association.org.uk>

This year the sessions will cover:

PUBERTY – GROWING & CHANGING

- Puberty & changes
- Correct names of female and male reproductive organs
- Periods (Menstruation) and products to use
- Wet dreams and erections & how to manage both
- Hygiene & keeping healthy

SEX EDUCATION – GROWING UP, MOVING ON & BECOMING YOUNG ADULTS

- Consent and keeping ourselves safe (Underpants rule)
- Reproduction
- Birth and babies
- Where to go for help and support
