Maths Challenge


Choose the times table which you find the most tricky: 2, 4, 5, 8 or 10.

If you were able to interview an Ancient Egyptian, what would you ask them? It could be a farmer, a slave, a queen or a pharaoh!




Make your own papyrus paper

You Will Need:

- brown paper or a brown paper bag
 - white glue and water mix
 - an empty clean yoghurt pot
 - small paint brush
 - coloured crayons or chalk
 - black pen
 - 1. Tear brown paper into thin strips.
- 2. Mix one part white glue to two parts water.
- 3. Layer and overlap the strips of paper on top of each other with the glue.
- 4. Layer vertically and horizontally to create a woven pattern.
 - 5. Leave to dry.
 - 6. Cut or tear the excess overlap off.
- 7. Draw your ancient Egyptian art with colouring crayons and outline with black pen.
