

As Historians we will...

explore conflict during the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for England. We will know how the Vikings travelled and explored in order to conquer Britain. We will also make links with our prior learning about conflict in Britain, further developing our understanding of the significance of rulers.

As Readers we will...

read and explore a wide range of texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will also develop our comprehension skills by using evidence from the text to support our answers.

As Writers we will...

explore an adapted version of Shakespeare's 'The Tempest', building up to a performance at the end of the summer term. We will use the setting and characters as inspiration for writing our own fantasy stories about a magical island.

As Scientists we will...

explore how sound is made and how it travels through our ears. Through investigations and our own research, we will accurately measure and explain patterns between the strength of a vibration and the volume of sound produced as a result. Alongside this, we will also investigate the volume of sound depending on its distance from a sound source and ask questions concerning the different pitches of sound that are produced from different objects.



As Mathematicians we will...

explore division with remainders. We will build upon our learning about time and convert between analogue and digital clocks. We will also review our concept of fractions ready to develop our understanding further after half term.

In PE we will...

develop our cooperative and teamwork skills through a variety of performance challenges.

In French we will...

learn vocabulary related to the classroom and be able to describe our school equipment, building on our understanding of grammar.

In Jigsaw we will...

explore the theme, 'Relationships'.

In Computing we will...

develop our understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be resaved and reused. In our e-safety lessons, we will explore online profiles and how first impressions can be made based on what we post online.

In the Arts we will...

develop our confidence in singing, improving our sense of rhythm and pitch as part of our weekly steel pan sessions in music.

As artists, we will begin to explore how 3D artist Darrel Wakelam uses sustainable resources to create a range of sculptures from recycled materials. We will explore creating a range of textures through our own sculpting.

In RE we will...

explore the theme 'Our world' through the question, 'Who cares?'
